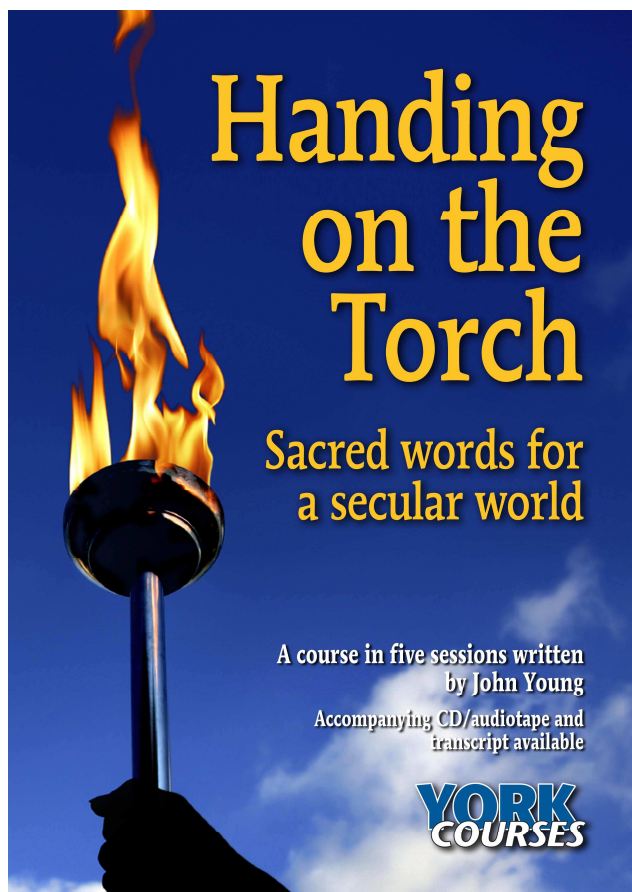


St. Cross Church, Knutsford
